

## **Program Summary & Orientation**

Upon arrival, the instructor, police officer and teen leaders will be introduced and discussion will begin. The children will be assigned to and called by color group to tour the "city."

The children will go outside to Safety City with the instructor, police officer and teen leaders. Parents will stay inside for orientation and information.

Half of the children will be in the classroom while the other half will be outside at "The City". They will switch. At the end of classes, children will go to their assigned houses and wait for their parents to pick them up.

In the event of inclement weather, children will remain inside for the session and will wait for parents inside.

## What is Safety City?



The American Red Cross Safety City program is an exciting, educational program for children who are registered to enter kindergarten this year. Safety City is designed to increase awareness in children by teaching fundamental safety skills. Unfortunately accidents are the leading cause of death and injury in America. Children, ages 1 to 10, have represented a disproportionately large percentage of the victims, yet there has been a large void in the availability of hands-on safety training for preschool-aged children.

The Licking County Chapter has utilized many of the Red Cross theories in safety training, adapting them to the comprehension level of preschoolers. Children will be introduced to motorist safety, caution with strangers, bicycle and school bus safety, fire safety, and drug and poison safety. Some learning is done in the classroom and some is done outside at 'The City'.

Safety City is a one-week program/ three hours per day and twenty students per session. There is a \$20.00, non-refundable enrollment fee per child.

### **Enrollment is limited!**

Payment may be made in person at our office or by phone, using a credit card. If you plan to mail a check, please note "Safety City" and the child's name in the memo section.

**Your child is not registered for Safety City if we have not received your payment before Day 1.**

\*New students will not be accepted after Day 2.

\*Students need to wear tennis shoes.

\*Students should not wear sundresses.

\*All students must bring a bicycle helmet each day beginning on Day 1.

\*Parents need to stay for the first day orientation and the last day for graduation.
